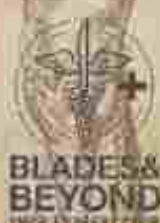

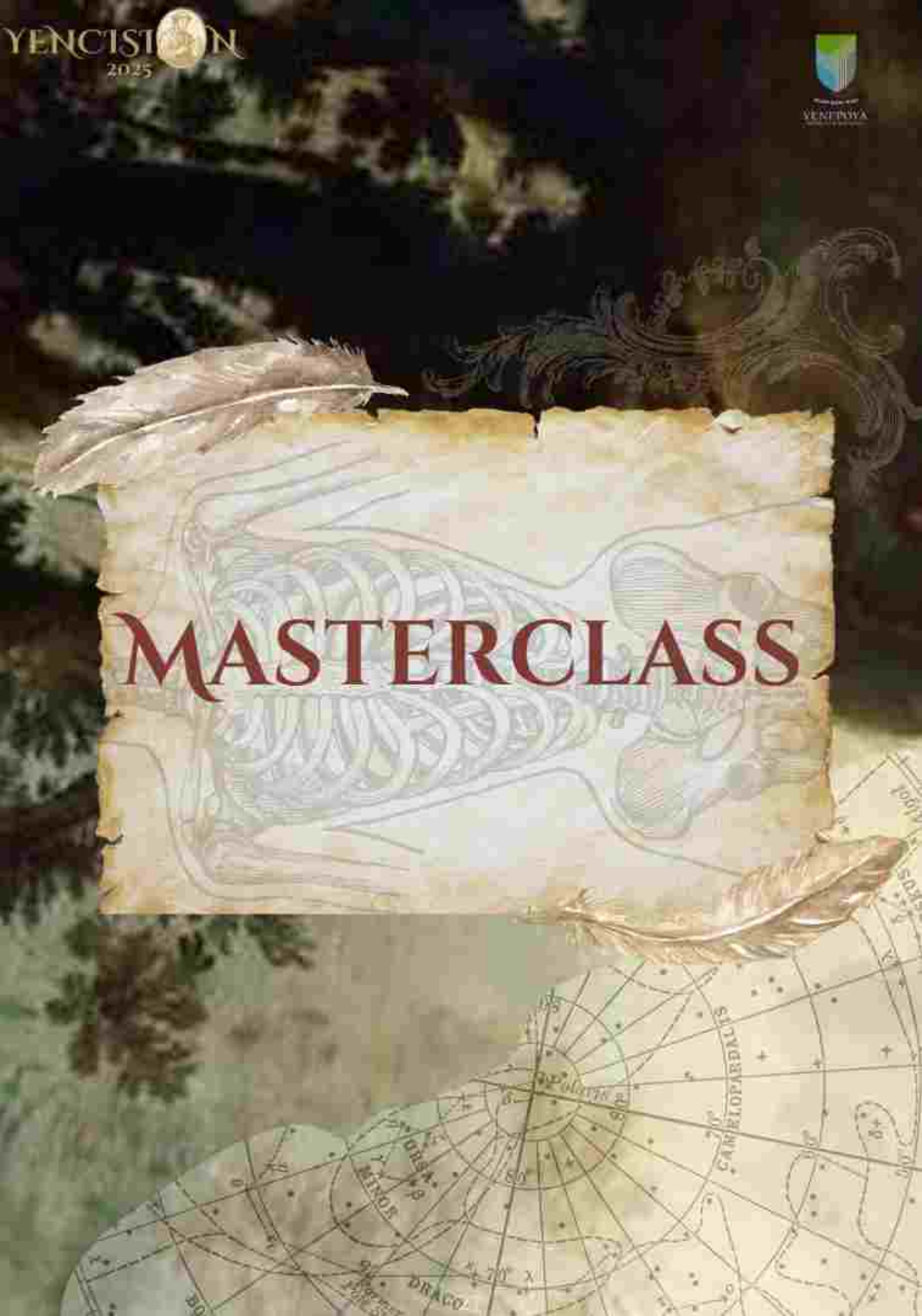

POSTER PRESENTATION RENAISSANCE IN RESEARCH

WHERE THE SPIRIT OF DISCOVERY IS REBORN

- The scientific committee will choose abstracts following an extensive evaluation.
- 1. The abstract must be the author's original work, with less than 10% similarity index. (Your abstract must be your own original writing and when checked for plagiarism it, should not have more than 10% similarity with existing published content.)
- 2. Any images used should be original and from the institution one belongs to, we recommend the use of high-definition images.
- 3. The confidentiality of the subject or patient should be maintained and consent should be taken.
- 4. Abstracts that are submitted must not have been presented in prior conferences.
- Time limit of 5 minutes + 2 minutes (presentation + Q&A Session)

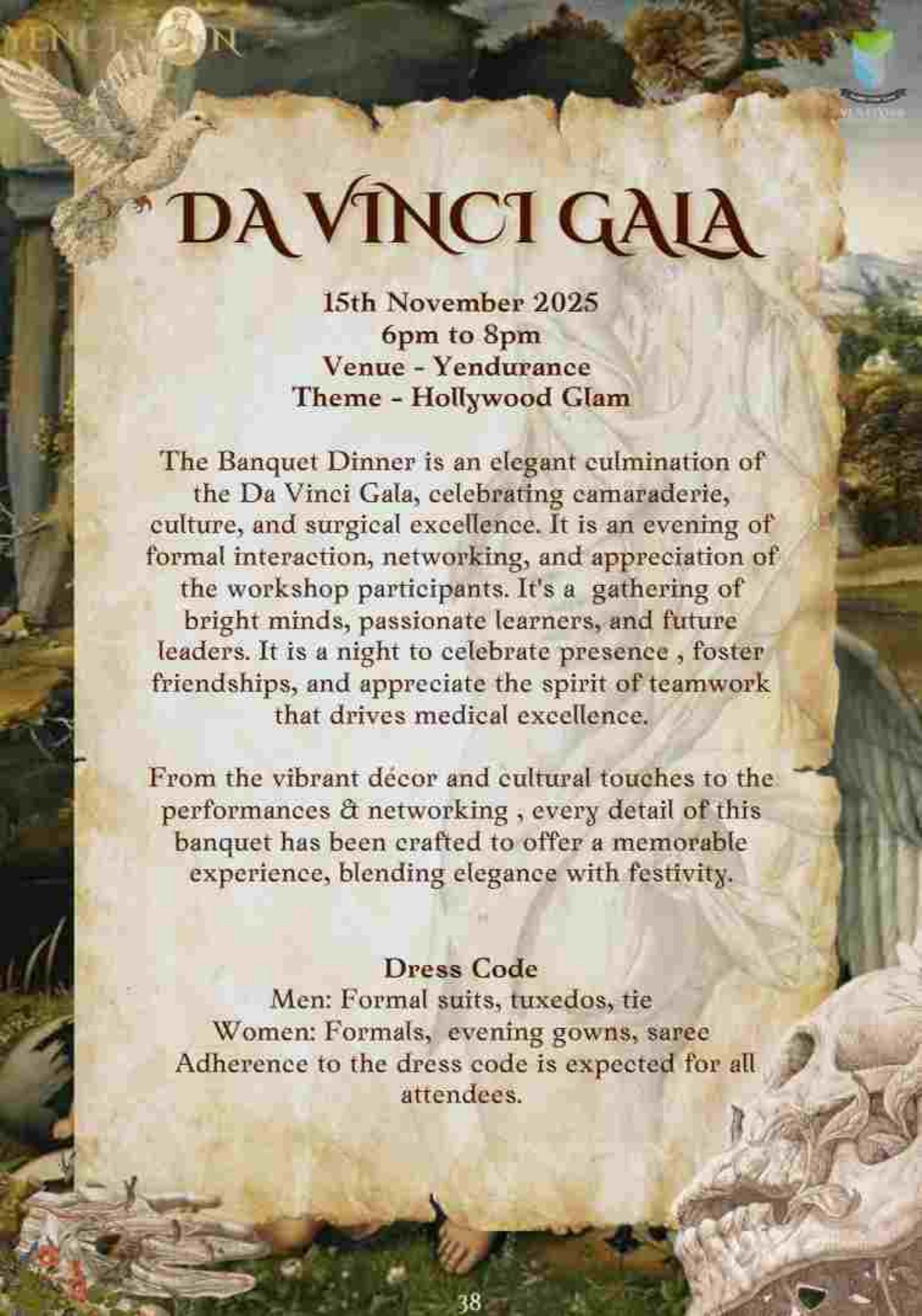

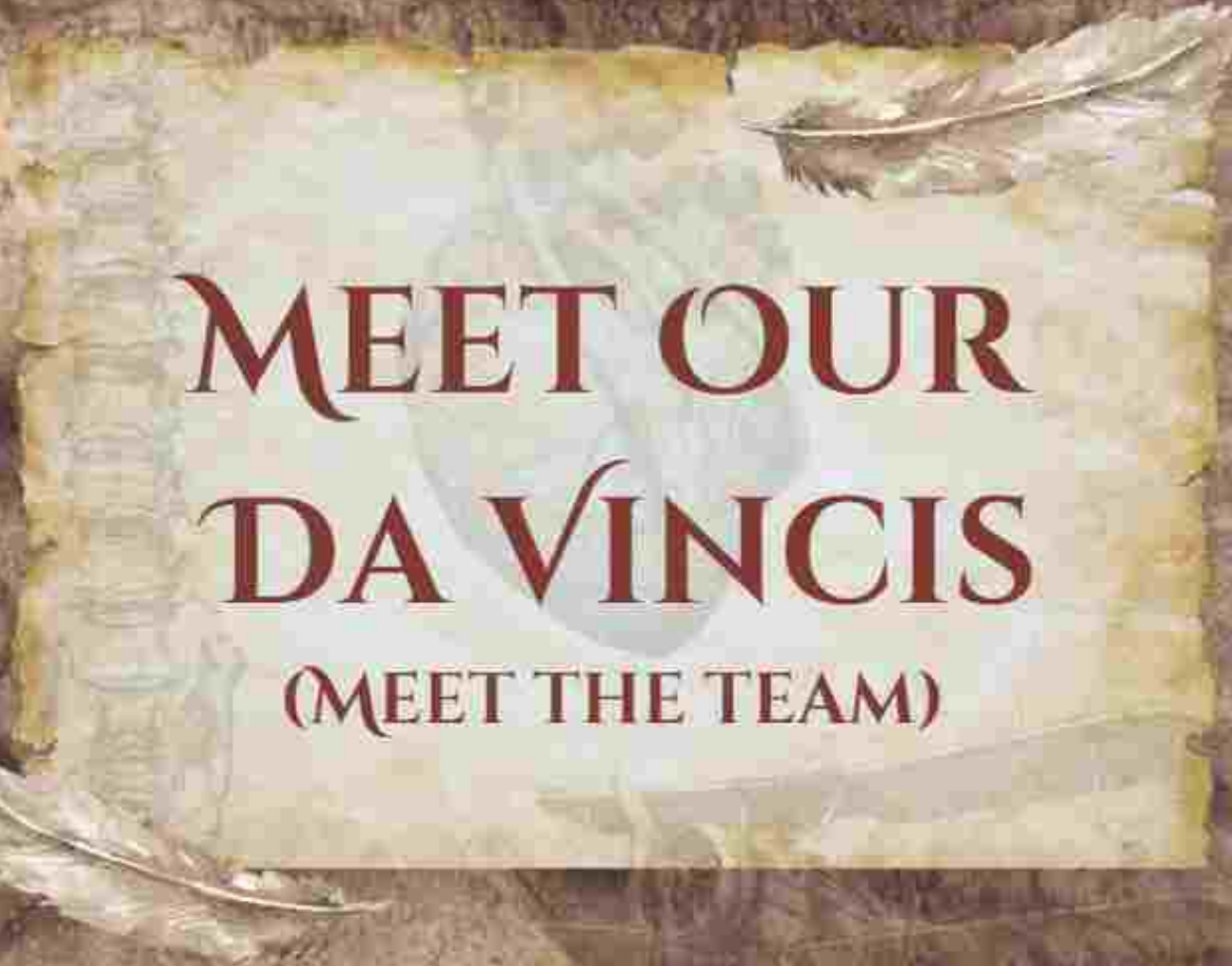
