# GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION



- ◆ The abstract should be computer typed in MS Word using Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing, and should not exceed 250 words.
- ◆ Presentation Type: Poster Presentation
- ◆ Title: The title should be short, concise, and written in Title Case.
- ◆ Author(s) Name(s) and Affiliation(s):
  - The presenting author's name must be underlined.
  - Author names should be followed by their institutional affiliation(s).
  - The email ID of the presenting author must be provided.
- ◆ The abstract must be structured under the following headings:
  - Introduction
  - Objectives
  - Materials and Methods
  - Results
  - Conclusion
- ◆ The abstract file must be uploaded along with the Google Form submission. Abstracts submitted via any other mode will not be considered.
- ◆ Abstract Submission Deadline:
  - Early Bird Registration: 20th February 2026
  - Late Breaking Registration: 28th February 2026
- ◆ Incomplete abstracts will be rejected without prior intimation.
- ◆ All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee, which reserves the right to accept or reject abstracts and to make the final decision regarding poster presentation.



## Tourist Attractions

**1. Someshwar Shiva Temple & Beach - 7 km**

**7. Pilikula Nisargadhama - 21 km**

An integrated eco-tourism and biodiversity park featuring a zoo, lake, botanical garden, and planetarium.



**8. Panambur Beach - 22 km**

One of Mangalore's most popular beaches, known for cleanliness, beach activities, and sunsets.
