## Report on Three-Day Long 'CCLS & STLS Training Program' at Yenepoya Medical College Hospital

The Department of Health and Family Welfare conducted the training for all the stakeholders for the successful implementation of 'Dr. Puneeth Rajkumar Hrudaya Jyothi Yojane' at Simulation Lab of the hospital.

As a preliminary course of the successful implementation of this scheme for cardiac health the three day 'CCLS & STLS Training Program' was conducted for medical officers, nurses, and ambulance staff on 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024 at the Simulation Lab, Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) Campus, Derelakatte.

The training program had a participation of around 70 First responders in the two districts across the three days.
