

Report on MOU signed between the Yenepoya (Deemed to be university) and High Commission of the Republic of Gambia

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed on 25/05/2024 between the Yenepoya (Deemed to be university) and High Commission of the Republic of Gambia to foster international cooperation in education, patient care, research, and community empowerment. This strategic collaboration encompasses a broad spectrum of disciplines in which both Gambia and Yenepoya have strong programmes of multi-lateral cooperation and interest.

The Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) has offered free scholarships to the students from Gambia to pursue their education here. The teaching hospital has offered low cost treatment facilities for the patients from Gambia

The MoU signing ceremony took place at 10:00 am following an interaction with the key individuals from the both sides.
