ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Healthcare-Associated Infections (HAIs) significantly impact modern healthcare by compromising patient safety, prolonging hospital stays, and increasing costs—especially in resource-limited settings with inconsistent infection control. Nurses, as key frontline caregivers, play a vital role in preventing HAIs through evidence-based care and vigilant surveillance.

To strengthen this role, a specialized workshop was developed to enhance nurses' knowledge, skills, and attitudes toward HAI prevention. Based on the principles of Stewardship, Safety, and Surveillance, the program equips nurses to identify risks, implement prevention strategies, support antimicrobial stewardship, and improve HAI monitoring—ultimately enhancing patient care quality.
