1. Workshops

However, to be included in the final program, all abstract presenters with accepted abstracts will need to register no later than **30th September 2023**. The conference organizers reserve the right to remove anyone from the conference proceedings and the final program who has not registered by this date.

Please note:

Authors may submit multiple abstracts for any presentation type (workshops, oral presentations, posters, Yenvision- Lightning talk). Any abstract submitted may be considered by reviewers for a different type of abstract than the one submitted (e.g., you have submitted for an oral presentation but could be accepted as a poster presentation).
