Report on Resume Writing Program Conducted by the Placement Cell Focusing on SDG

Introduction:

On 28th of February 2025, the Placement Cell of Yenepoya Dental College, organized a Resume Writing Program for Interns aimed at preparing students for the job market. The session focused on enhancing the employability skills of students by providing them with tools to craft effective, professional resumes.

Additionally, the program included a unique focus on aligning career aspirations with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), emphasizing the role students can play in advancing these global goals through their professional careers.

Dr. Sham S Bhat, Dean, Faculty of Dentistry, Chairperson of Placement Cell, YDC welcomed the gathering. Dr. Laxmikanth Chatra, Principal, Yenepoya Dental College gave the introductory remarks and addressed the Interns. Dr. Haziell Jenifer, Convenor of Placement Cell delivered the vote of thanks.

Objectives:

To educate students on the importance of crafting a well-structured, impactful resume.

To provide practical tips on highlighting relevant skills, experiences, and achievements.

To raise awareness about the SDGs and explore how students can integrate them into their professional profiles.

Key Highlights:

Resume Writing Techniques:

The session was led by Dr. Vidya Bhat S, Professor, Department of Prosthodontics, YDC.

Participants were introduced to various resume formats, including chronological, functional, and hybrid models. The importance of tailoring resumes to specific job roles, keeping them concise, and highlighting key achievements was emphasized.

Incorporating SDGs in Resumes:

The program also included a session on how students can align their resumes with the principles of the SDGs. Topics covered included:

SDG 4 (Quality Education): Highlighting academic achievements, certifications, and courses that promote education and lifelong learning.

SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth): Focusing on internships, volunteer work, and part-time jobs that demonstrate professional growth and development.

SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities): Showcasing involvement in diversity and inclusion initiatives, leadership roles, and advocacy.

Interactive Sessions:

The students actively participated in a resume-building program. The interactive nature of the program allowed students to have a clear understanding of the resume crafting and a clear direction on improving their professional documents.

Q&A and Networking:

The session concluded with a Q&A where students were encouraged to ask questions related to resume writing and career planning.

Outcome:

Increased Awareness: Students were made aware of how their personal and professional actions can contribute to the achievement of SDGs.

Improved Resume Skills: The participants acquired an improved understanding of how to craft compelling resumes tailored to both the job market and global needs.

Conclusion:

The Resume Writing Program conducted by the Placement Cell was a successful initiative in equipping students with the skills necessary to enter the job market confidently.

The focus on SDGs added a valuable dimension to the program, encouraging students to think beyond personal success and consider the broader impact they can make in their respective fields. Through such initiatives, Yenepoya Dental College continues to guide students in becoming responsible professionals committed to sustainable development.

Feedback and Recommendations for Future Sessions:

56 Interns participated in the Resume Writing program. Online feedback was also collected from the Interns at the end of the session through Google Forms.

Around 65% of the interns gave feedback that the program content and relevance was excellent and would like to have mock interviews and exploring opportunities in India and abroad in the next program.

Future sessions:

Host follow-up workshops focusing on interview preparation and SDG- aligned career pathways.

Incorporate hands-on resume review sessions with alumni working in sustainability-focused industries.

An informal networking session allowing students to interact with industry professionals, alumni, and peers to gain further insights into building careers.

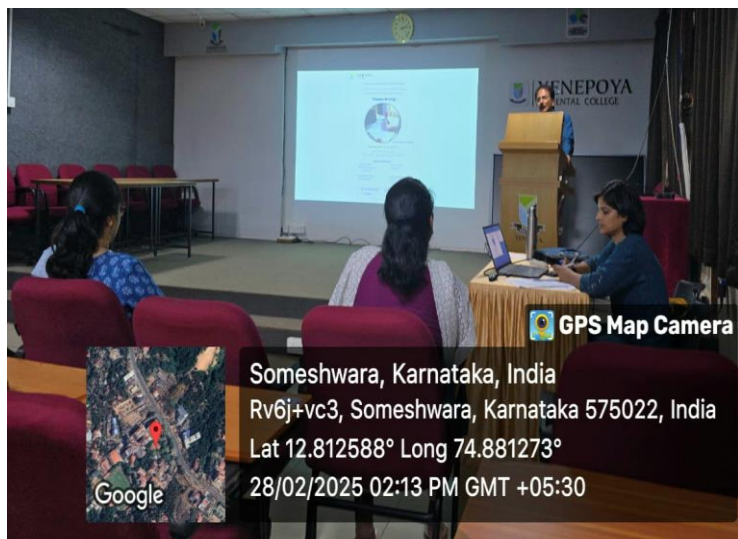

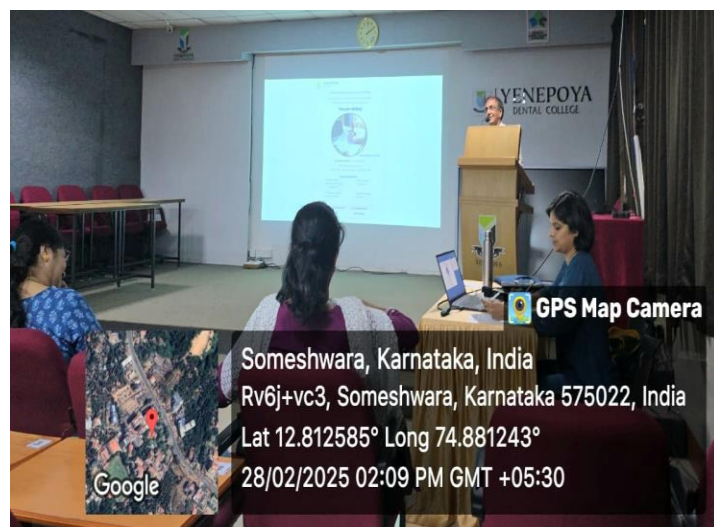
